Focus – School Ties

Recently, there has been a strong emphasis on uniform standards across the school, with the focus originally on jeans and trousers. The focus on trousers continues to be successfully tackled by the staff, however, the Pupil Leadership Team (Head Boy and Girl, House Captains and Prefects) have decided to focus on another aspect: Ties.

This term, S6 pupils will be going into S1 Citizenship classes and Registration classes to deliver lessons on how to properly tie and wear a tie. These lessons will also be accompanied by a collection of posters displaying what their tie should look like, which will be posted around the school. We have also asked the Senior Leadership Team to run a Tie loan service (cloakroom) where pupils without ties can borrow a tie for the day. Parents will also be encouraged to ensure their children's ties are tied properly.

The Pupil Leadership Team were selected through a rigorous process involving a personal statement, group work presentation and an interview with a member of Senior Management and an S3 pupil. Uniform is one of the main issues the Pupil Leadership Team aims to address by the end of the year, and we hope to have your full support in improving the overall image of the school.
